Nos casos de artigos científicos publicados no âmbito de projetos europeus do H2020, a frase referência a colocar-se na secção "Acknowledgments" deve ser como a que aparece no exemplo seguinte:

"The research leading to these results has received funding from the European Union's Horizon 2020 - The EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation 2014-2020, under grant agreement No. [number]."

Rules for "Acknowledgments" in scientific articles

EUROPEAN PROJECTS

For scientific articles published as part of European projects, the reference made in the Acknowledgements should be the following:

"The research leading to these results has received funding from the European Union's Horizon 2020 - The EU Framework Programme for Research and Innovation 2014-2020, under grant agreement No. [number]."

Obrigações de disseminação e comunicação

Caros Responsáveis de projetos H2020 no INESC TEC,

A propósito de um e-mail recebido recentemente a relembrar as nossas obrigações de disseminação e comunicação nos projetos europeus H2020, vimos alertar para o cumprimento das seguintes regras:

ARTICLE 29 — DISSEMINATION OF RESULTS — OPEN ACCESS — VISIBILITY OF EU FUNDING

29.2 Open access to scientific publications (pág. 242 [h2020-amga_en.pdf](#))

Each beneficiary must ensure open access (free of charge, online access for any user) to all peer-reviewed scientific publications relating to its results. In particular, it must:

(a) as soon as possible and at the latest on publication, deposit a machine-readable electronic copy of the published version or final peer-reviewed manuscript accepted for publication in a repository for scientific publications;

Moreover, the beneficiary must aim to deposit at the same time the research data needed to validate the results presented in the deposited scientific publications

(b) ensure open access to the deposited publication — via the repository — at the latest:

(i) on publication, if an electronic version is available for free via the publisher, or
(ii) within six months of publication (twelve months for publications in the social sciences and humanities) in any other case.

(c) ensure open access — via the repository — to the bibliographic metadata that identify the deposited publication.

The bibliographic metadata must be in a standard format and must include all of the following:

- the terms ["European Union (EU)" and "Horizon 2020"] ["Euratom" and Euratom research and training programme 2014-2018'];
- the name of the action, acronym and grant number;
- the publication date, and length of embargo period if applicable, and a persistent identifier.

29.4 Information on EU funding (pág. 244 [h2020-amga_en.pdf](#))

Obligation and right to use the EU emblem

Unless the [Commission][Agency] requests or agrees otherwise or unless it is impossible, any dissemination of results (in any form, including electronic) must:

- a) display the EU emblem and
- b) include the following text:

“This project has received funding from the [European Union’s Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme][Euratom research and training programme 2014-2018] under grant agreement No [Number]”.

When displayed together with another logo, the EU emblem must have appropriate prominence.

Article 29.5 Disclaimer excluding [Commission][Agency] responsibility (pág. 244 [h2020-amga_en.pdf](#))

Any dissemination of results must indicate that it reflects only the author's view and that the [Commission][Agency] is not responsible for any use that may be made of the information it contains.

It does not necessarily reflect the opinion of the [\[Insert the name of the Agency\]](#) or the European Commission (EC). [\[Insert the name of the Agency\]](#) or the EC are not responsible for any use that may be made of the information contained therein.

ARTICLE 38.1 COMMUNICATION ACTIVITIES BY BENEFICIARIES

38.1.1 Obligation to promote the action and its results (pág. 277 [h2020-amga_en.pdf](#))

The beneficiaries must promote the action and its results, by providing targeted information to multiple audiences (including the media and the public) in a strategic and effective manner.

This does not change the dissemination obligations in Article 29, the confidentiality obligations in Article 36 or the security obligations in Article 37, all of which still apply.

38.1.2 Information on EU funding (pág. 277 [h2020-amga_en.pdf](#))

Obligation and right to use the EU emblem Unless the [Commission][Agency] requests or agrees otherwise or unless it is impossible, any communication activity related to the action (including in electronic form, via social media, etc.) and any infrastructure, equipment and major results funded by the grant must:

- (a) display the EU emblem (attached logo) and
- (b) include the following text:

For communication activities: "This project has received funding from the [European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme][Euratom research and training programme 2014-2018] under grant agreement No [number]".

For infrastructure, equipment and major results: "This [infrastructure][equipment] [insert type of result] is part of a project that has received funding from the [European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme][Euratom research and training programme 2014-2018] under grant agreement No [number]".

When displayed together with another logo, the EU emblem must have appropriate prominence.

38.1.3 Disclaimer excluding [Agency and] Commission responsibility (pág. 277 [h2020-amga_en.pdf](#))

Any communication activity related to the action must indicate that it reflects only the author's view and that the Agency and the Commission [is] [are] not responsible for any use that may be made of the information it contains.

Obligations on acknowledgement of EU funding and disclaimer for all project-related communication activities (including in electronic form, via social media, etc.) and any infrastructure, equipment and major results funded by the grant. Please make sure all communication material (brochure, leaflets, presentations to events, etc.) and infrastructure, demo etc. carry the right ack of EU funding.

Please check this article, to ensure all publications deriving from the project are open access (29.2) and include correct acknowledgement of EU funding (29.4) and disclaimer (29.5). At periodic reporting, in the portal you will have to include a link to the online repository where each publication is available open access.

ARTICLE 38 — PROMOTING THE ACTION – VISIBILITY OF EU FUNDING, please see the similar obligations on acknowledgement of EU funding and disclaimer for all project-related communication activities (including in electronic form, via social media, etc.) and any infrastructure, equipment and major results funded by the grant. Please make sure all communication material (brochure, leaflets, presentations to events, etc.) and infrastructure, demo etc. carry the right ack of EU funding.

Please make sure that also the deliverables include the acknowledgement and the disclaimer in their template (please check the articles to see the correct ack/disclaimer to use).
