Work Area: Image Analysis and Machine Learning web service for Screening Diabetic retinopathy
Project overview: This post-doctoral grant is integrated in the project SCREEN-DR- Image Analysis and Machine Learning Platform for
Innovation in Diabetic Retinopathy Screening, a research initiative under the Carnegie Mellon University | Portugal program. The main goals of
the project are to advance the Machine Learning Research for Detection and Grading of Diabetic Retinopathy (DR). The researcher will
develop Image Analysis and Machine Learning web service client prototype for Screening Diabetic retinopathy.
Objectives: The objective of the grant is to develop a web service that allows remote procedure calls to image analysis programs developed
for Image Quality detection; Image Normality Detection and Diabetic Retinopathy grading. An image client prototype, that uses the web

service, should also be developed. The web service and the client prototype should be validated in a DR screening environment, in a pilot setting.

Academic Qualifications:	PhD Comp. Science or Inform. Engineering or Elec. and Comp. Eng.or Biomedical Eng.
Minimum Profile required:	The candidates need to demonstrate experience in image analysis or machine learning and general programming skills.
Preference factors:	As preference factors are experience in image analysis, machine learning and web programming together with general programming skills. Publication experience in conferences and journals.
Monthly Grant:	€1495,00 according to the Stipends values of the grants awarded directly by the FCT, paid by bank transfer. The grant holder can receive additional payments by participating in complementary contracts or projects that contribute to the work plan (Clauses 12 and 13 of INESC TEC Grants Regulation and Annex II), in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 5 of Research Grant Holder Statute, approved by Law n 40/2004, dated 18 August, up to a maximum of 50% of the monthly grant.
