Work Area:	Information systems, health systems, health care management, hospital logistics, operations research
Project overview:	The KNOWLOGIS project consists of an intelligent dashboard capable of monitoring hospital information systems, constantly on the lookout for efficiency gains in day-to-day operations, in particular inventory management, budgeting, procurement, etc. It uses technologies such as .NET Core, R, REST/Web Services, Docker, etc. The candidate will be working closely with the project partners: an IT company (Glintt) and a public hospital (CHVNG) in implementing the dashboard.
Objectives:	Develop the use cases further; Work on machine learning algorithms; help implementing the dashboard; incorporate hospital planning into the forecasts; estimate the budget impact of operational changes; participate in focus groups/user experience sessions.

Academic Qualifications:	Master in Industrial Engineering and Management, Computer Science ou related areas.
Minimum Profile required:	Analytical and coding skills.
Preference factors:	Research or working experience in the fields of health care, operations research.
