Work Area: Predictive Maintenance

Project overview: The work is developed within the UP4Legacy project whose aim is to retrofit existing manufacturing machines with sensors and data acquisition equipment. This data will then be used to implement and test failure detection and prediction models. The results will be evaluated and demonstrated with a prototype.

Objectives: Specify, develop, test, integrate and document an information system dedicated to fault prediction of industrial equipment dedicated to the metalworking industry, integrating fault detection and prediction models and IIoT platforms. The implementation will be developed for web environments.
