Work Area: Creation and management of innovation hubs

Project overview: This grant is framed within the work that INESC TEC has been carrying out with several industrial partners and from the technological and scientific system with the goal of creating innovation hubs, which add unique value to products, processes and services for a competitive and sustainable Portuguese Industry.

Objectives: The main objective of this research grant is to study the creation and management of innovation hubs in Europe, that were promoted by specific policy initiatives of the European Commission such as "Digitising European Industry" or "EIT Innovation Communities".

Academic Qualifications:	PhD in Industrial Engineering and Management or Engineering and Public Policy.
Minimum Profile required:	Fluency in English (spoken and written). Experience in publishing scientific articles.
